

Tips for Cleaning & Care of Vanity Set

Room Air Conditions

1.Regardless of whether the surfaces are varnished, coated or naturally treated, bathroom furniture is suitable for normal bathroom air conditions. Temporary increases in humidity do not damage the furniture as long as the moisture is taken away by means of adequate ventilation. Splashed water, condensation or standing water must be removed immediately with a dry cloth, since prolonged exposure can lead to moisture damage or mould formation.

2.Swelling of the material due to improper treatment does not represent a claim due to product deficiencies/ claim under warranty!

3.Front and body surfaces (synthetic material/varnish), cupboard interiors (drawers, shelves, etc.)

1)If possible, remove accumulating grime immediately. Often, cleaning agents are not necessary. Best is the use of lukewarm water and a soft, damp cloth. In order to avoid swelling, always rub the surfaces dry afterwards.

2)To remove tough stains, we recommend using warm, soapy water or a mild household cleaner. Always rub surfaces dry if they are still damp in any way.

Wooden Fronts (Solid or Veneered)

Wood is a living material with natural color, structure and growth differences, which are not covered by our warranty. Different types of light and sun exposure lead to discoloration, which is dependent on the material. Therefore, these are not grounds for claims. Different levels of humidity can cause wood to move, swell, and contract. This can lead to slight protrusions (depending on the type of wood) on solid wood frames, for example. Wood should not be subjected to extremely humid or extremely dry air. A normal humidity of 45 to 70% is ideal for processed wood. Provision of sufficient ventilation is therefore necessary, e.g. while showering. The surfaces are protected by high-quality, multi-layered varnishes. This makes the surfaces highly resistant to dirt.

Clean with a slightly damp cloth or a soft, damp brush. Always wipe in the direction of the grain of the wood. In order to prevent residual moisture in the grooves, in the corners and on the edges, rub the surfaces dry. Do not follow grime to dry and remove immediately.

Regardless of the surface, never use the following cleaning agents:

Aggressive fluid cleaners, nitro based solutions, grinding or abrasive cleaning agents, oily polishes with silicone, Waxes and solvents, microfibers cloths.

Please do not use a steam cleaner. This leads to swelling and destroys the furniture.
